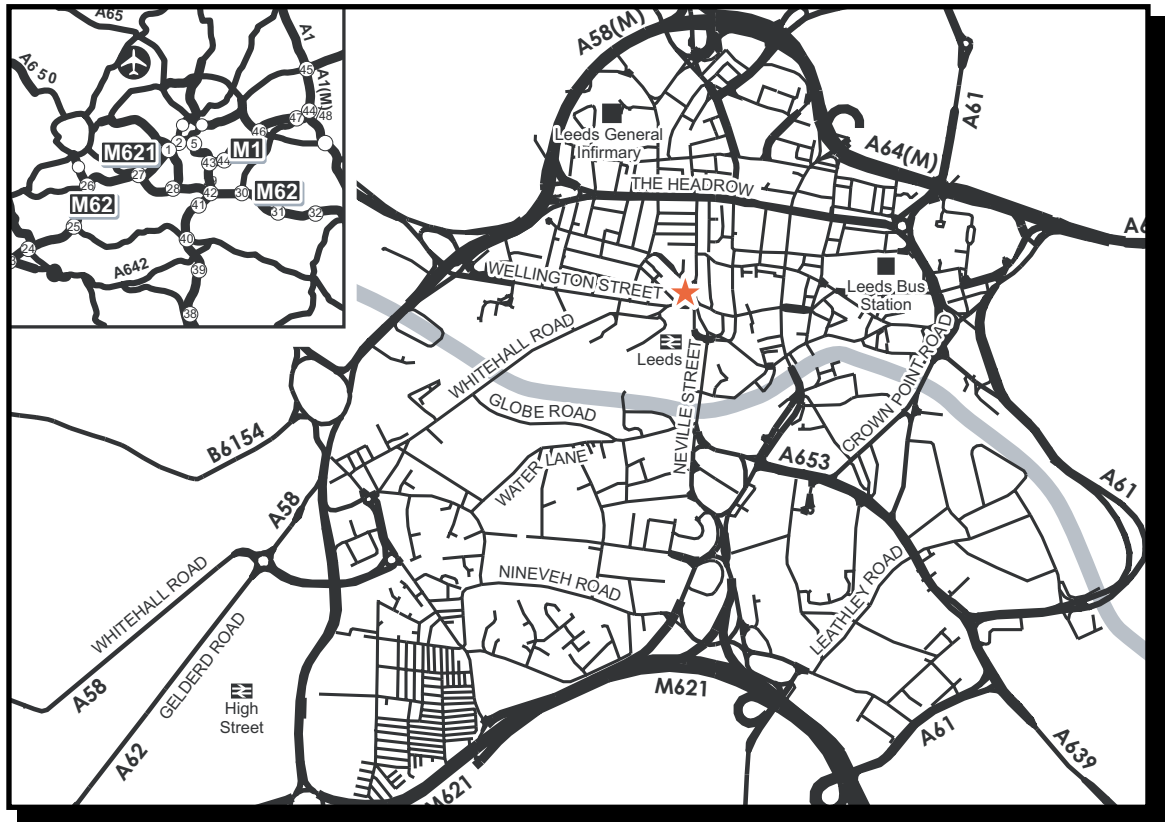


Where We Work – Leeds



Our Leeds office is located at:

Directions by rail: Regular train services run to and from all parts of the country. Approximate journey times are:

To/from London – 135 minutes
Manchester – 60 minutes
Newcastle – 90 minutes
Liverpool – 115 minutes
Edinburgh – 180 minutes

The office is a two-minute walk from Leeds City Station, although taxis are always available.

Directions by air: Leeds-Bradford Airport is 10 miles from the city centre with an approximate road journey time of 25 minutes.

Directions by road:

From M1 South: Just south of Leeds the M1 leads into the M621. Leave at junction 3 (Leeds Centre).

From M1 North: Leave at junction 44, follow signs for M621 and then leave at junction 3.

From M62 East: Leave at junction 29 and join M621. Leave at junction 3.

From M62 West: Leave at junction 27 and join M621. Leave at junction 3.

From junction 3: Head for Leeds Centre. Go past the Hilton Hotel on the left-hand side and under the main railway bridge. At the second set of lights all traffic has to turn left past Queens Hotel. Move into the right-hand lane and go up Quebec Street to the lights. Turn right at the lights and then right at the next lights (Allied Irish Bank on corner) into Infirmary Street (entry to Infirmary Street is restricted to buses, taxis, and access). Go down the right-hand lane to the lights (pelican crossing). After the lights turn immediately left down the side of No 1 City Square; entry to the car park is on the right-hand side.

Outward journey: Following changes in the road system in Leeds, visitors driving to the office will need to take a different route back to the motorways. Probably the most direct route to both the M1 and M62 is via the inner ring road. On leaving our building, traffic restrictions require all drivers to go around City Square and pass in front of the Queens Hotel. After passing the hotel take the road that runs down the left-hand side of the Majestyk Nightclub (Wellington Street). After about 1/2 a mile

(at the Yorkshire Post Building) turn left onto the ring road where directions to the motorway are clearly marked. At the M621 junction drivers should turn left for the M1 (North and South) and M62 (East), and right for the M62 (West).

Car parking: We have car parking spaces available at No 1 City Square which can be booked prior to your visit. Public car parks are within easy walking distance and there are also a number of parking meters in the vicinity.
